CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS

- 1. The right to a fair trial by an impartial jury of one's peers.
- 2. The right to a speedy and public trial.
- 3. The right to be informed of the charges against one.
- 4. The right to confront and cross-examine witnesses.
- 5. The right to the assistance of legal counsel.
- 6. The right to remain silent.
- 7. The right to stop answering questions at any time.
- 8. The right to talk to a lawyer for advice before any questioning and to have him with one during questioning.
- 9. The right to stop answering questions at any time.
- 10. The right to be informed of these rights before any questioning.
